Come out and help get Kennekuk County Park ready for the busy spring and summer months by volunteering to:

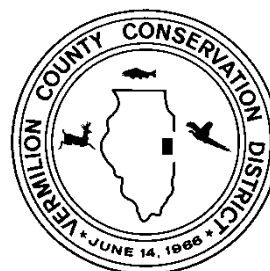
- Plant Trees
